GENERAL REGULATIONS

All OMC World and Zone Cups are organized and directed by OMC HAIRWORLD INC. Registration is open to all OMC member country organizations on individual basis.

1. OMC World Cup Automatic Team Selection

All OMC member country organizations register all their competitors on individual basis in the concerned categories. OMC World Cup: The top 3 competitors with the highest accumulated scores will form the country team. The team can consist of competitors from different organizations in a country, because the team is based on national, not organizational winners. All OMC tests are won on individual basis first.

2. OMC Zone Cup Automatic Team Selection

The top 2 competitors with the highest accumulated scores will form the country team. The team can consist of competitors from different organizations in a country, because the team is based on national, not on organizational winners. All OMC tests are won on individual basis first.

3. <u>Cancellation of teams</u>

If there are less than 3 teams in a category registered for a World Cup, the Team World Champion title will be cancelled. In this case, the competitors will be allowed to compete on individual basis. If the individual competitors are less than 5, OMC has the final decision to change the title and diplomas to "OMC International Champion. The countries concerned will be informed of the cancelations two weeks after the registration deadline.

4. Registration Conditions

Only countries that are members of OMC and have paid their current membership dues may take part in the Ladies and/or Gents Section of the OMC World, Western Europe Zone, Central Europe Zone, Eastern Europe Zone, Asia, Americas Zone Cups.

Registration is guaranteed up to the deadline. Registration payments ONLY through OMC member organizations.

Only one payment by wire transfer by the national organization after approval of invoice for their national competitors.

5. <u>Competitor Citizenship and Residency</u>

Competitors can compete either for their country of residency or for their country of origin, as long as they are members of the national OMC member organization of the respective country.

6. <u>Competitor and Model Release</u>

The competitors and models must sign a release and send it to the OMC office together with the registration forms. The countries/organizations are responsible for competitors sending the Competitor and Model Release. OMC and the host country shall not be liable for any damage resulting from non-submitting of the Competitor and Model Release.

7. <u>Competitor Registration Fees</u>

All registration fees for all competitions are fixed by OMC HAIRWORLD INC.

Payments can only be made by the national organizations per bank transfer, no personal checks. If despite this instruction, individual competitors pay their registration fees themselves per bank transfer, they must take in charge all bank fees related to their payment, making sure that OMC HW INC. receives the precise amount mentioned on the registration form. If this is not the case, participation in the competition will be refused.

No registration payments of any kind will be accepted on site at the event.

8. Registration Files

The registration files must include the names of the competitors and address of the organization.

OMC will check all registrations. If registrations are correct, the OMC members will receive an invoice to be paid at receipt.

The OMC member country organizations are directly and fully responsible for all competitors they enroll. The OMC cannot be made responsible for any infractions to the present regulations perpetrated by its member.

In case an OMC member country organization or individual competitor(s) are found to have acted against these rules, either during or after the event, its champion title will be withdrawn, the competitor(s) concerned will be disqualified, it will have to give back to the OMC all awards that were given to the competitor (s) concerned, and a sanction will be attributed to the OMC member.

9. <u>Junior Age Limit 22 years (day of 23rd birthday excluded)</u>

At registration, the countries must send the necessary documents proving the age of their junior competitors. At registration on site when picking up the delegation bags, passports or legal ID proof of all junior competitors must be brought and will be checked. In case no proof is provided, the junior competitor/s concerned will be disqualified from the Championship. If an OMC member organization or an individual competitor is found to have produced the wrong age ID, the competitor will be disqualified, the champion title will be withdrawn, and it will be made public to all OMC member countries.

Juniors are not allowed to compete in seniors tests in the same championship.

OMC Junior Championships - Individual and Team

All junior competition tests are held under the title "OMC Junior Championship".

10. <u>Time-Schedule</u>

All participants will receive a time-schedule. In World and Zone Cups, they must be present one hour before the competition starts. Competitors who start their competition work too late will not be given any extra time.

11. <u>Canceling or Rescheduling of Competitions</u>

OMC reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any competition deemed necessary in its sole and exclusive discretion. OMC reserves the right to cancel any competition test if the number of competitors is five (5) or less for any OMC international championship. The member organizations that have registered competitors will be informed of the decision after the official registration is completed, and the registration fees of the cancelled tests will be refunded.

OMC Cancelation Fee Policy

Registration fees will not be reimbursed to competitors who cancel their participation after the deadline.

12. Claims

Competitors of OMC member organizations have 30 days after the event to make claims.

General Instructions for Competitions

Ladies / Gents / Seniors / Juniors

1. Combination Tests

Combination tests cannot be performed separately, unless explicitly stated in the competition rules.

2. <u>Mirror Numbers</u>

The General Commissioner will call a representative of each country and give him/her an envelope containing the mirror numbers of all competitors of his/her country. He/she will give these mirror numbers to his/her country's competitors. The competitors proceed to their working stations before the competition starts. The General Commissioner checks if the mirror numbers coincide with the competitors' names.

The Competitors' mirror numbers can be the same in the Combination Tests.

3. Models

In World and Europe Cups, the models have to wear the capes supplied by OMC.

The models are not allowed to help the competitors with the hairstyle (i.e. hair drying, touching the hair, etc.).

4. Penalties

Infringements to competition rules and non-observation of instructions concerning the competitions will be penalized by the Committee of Wise Men, according to the penalty point chart in force. The competitors will be informed of their penalty points via the results list.

The minimum base penalty points per infraction is 25 points, plus 5 penalty points for not observing the stop instruction.

5. Supports

The use of any kind of support will be penalized.

Make-up

Any inappropriate make-up in the Gents and Ladies Section may be interpreted as a recognition sign to jurors and will be penalized.

7. Clothing

Ladies models' / mannequin heads' clothing must be neutral and show no signs of any kind (logos, designer names).

Gents clothing must have a masculine look, jackets are required. A flyer of what not to present will be sent out to all countries. Mannequin heads' clothing must be neutral and show no signs of logos or designer names.

8. All Ladies and Gents Fashion categories tests must be commercially oriented

9. Number of registrations per competitor

Competitors can only register once per test.

10. <u>Disqualification</u>

- a) Use of mannequin heads from other than OMC official sponsors.
- b) Competitors changing assigned mirror numbers with other competitors.

11. Mannequin head presentation

During jurification, the mannequin heads can be placed on their supports fixed on the dressing tables or can be left on the tripods. The tripods can be dressed up (at the competitor's choice). It is not allowed to leave tools or other objects on the dressing tables.

OMC INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION AWARDS SYSTEM

Senior Titles: The title of OMC World Champion is awarded only to senior competitors.

OMC will present the Zone Team Award of the concerned categories to the second places of the OMC Team World Cup Winners.

OMC Platinum Sponsor Creative Color Award Sr Ladies and Gents (only in HW) 4.

Wella Creative Color Award presented to the winners of the Ladies and Gents Creative MH L'Oréal Creative Color Award presented to the winners of the Ladies Day Style LM / MH Takara Creative Color Award presented to the winners of the Ladies Bridal LM Gents Fashion Style MH

5. **Awards to Trainers**

The official trainers of the senior and junior top 3 teams of the Ladies' and the Gent's combination categories will receive the trainer medal and a diploma. The 4th and 5th team trainers will receive diplomas.

6. **Return of the OMC Senior World Cups**

The winners of the preceding senior World Cups must hand the cups to OMC no later than one day before the Championship. If this cannot be done for whatever reason, the national organizations holding the cups must inform OMC three months prior to the championship and will pay a fine of 5000 Euros to OMC.

COMMITTEE OF WISE MEN

The main task of the Committee of Wise Men is to help the competitors not to commit any infractions, as long as they comply with the competition rules.

- 1. The official Committee of Wise Men in both the Ladies and Gent's Hairdressing Section is composed of all the Competition Directors present. If not enough official Competition Directors are present, the OMC Global Director or the General Commissioners may appoint knowledgeable people to carry out the tasks of the Wise Men.
- 2. Before the competition starts, the Wise Men will go to the floor as a group to check the models. They will see if the competitors have abided by the competition rules. If any infraction is found, penalty points will be given to the competitor by marking the mirror number on the penalty chart, the letter of the infraction committed, and the amount of penalty points.
- 3. When the competition starts, the Wise Men will separate and observe the competition individually. If they see a competitor commit an infraction, they will record on paper the competitor's mirror number and the infraction that occurred. They will then give it to the General Commissioner who will discuss it with the Wise Men as a group and a decision will be reached.
- 4. All decisions made by the Committee of Wise Men, such as the penalty point list, will be signed by all members of the Committee of Wise Men personally. All members of the Committee of Wise Men will receive a photocopy for double-checking purposes. The General Commissioner then forwards the official list to the computer staff in a wax-sealed envelope. When the jury lists are first processed into the computer, the Wise Men's envelope is opened and also entered into the computer, if any penalty points have occurred.
- 5. The Committee of Wise Men must record the penalty points by taking a photo of the infraction. The photo is a sustainable proof of the infraction (except for the stop instruction). If no photo of the infraction was made, no proof is available, therefore the infraction cannot be penalized.

PENALTY POINTS LADIES Seniors & Juniors 25 penalty points per infraction for the Committee of Wise Men. 5 penalty points for not observing the stop instruction. Every infraction must be confirmed by two other Wise Men, plus the General Commissioner. The photo of every infraction must be recorded.

Test 1 OMC Creative

Ladies - Technical Combination Category (with Hair by Night)
Mannequin Head
Automatic Combination Team Selection
No competitor age indication - all ages accepted

The competitors proceed to the assigned working stations with their mannequin heads prepared in advance. The competitors will be asked to brush the hair. During the passage of the Wise Men, all competitors will be asked to move away from their mannequin heads and wait on the side of the competition floor. After the passage of the Wise Men who will brush all mannequins' hair in the direction that was prepared, the General Commissioner will call the competitors back to their mirrors and start the competition.

1. **Styling tools** All styling tools are allowed.

2. **Shaving** Shaving the mannequin head is forbidden. At finish, the minimum hair length must be 3 cm.

3. **Products** All fixing products are allowed.

4. **Color** A maximum of 3 harmonious transition color shades can be used, including the base color.

The colors green and blue are forbidden. Spray colors are forbidden.

5. **Supports** The use of any kind of supports in the hairstyle is forbidden.

6. **Hair Additions** Hairpieces and ornaments of all kinds are forbidden.

7. **Extensions** Hair extensions are allowed, but must be applied prior to the test to create volume and add

length and colors. They must not be applied all in one place to form a hairpiece or pony tail.

8. **Jury** The Jury will judge the general impression of the style and color. When judging, the judges

must be able to see the complete hairstyle, including the top. If this is not the case, the

stewards will put the mannequin holders lower.

9. <u>Time</u> <u>15 minutes</u>

(3 additional minutes will be granted for dressing the mannequin heads after the announcement by the General Commissioner. No additional time will be given. Competitors

who do not respect this rule will be penalized by 5 points).

10. Scores Maximum: 30 points

Minimum: 25 points

No electric plugs and no mirrors are available in the competitor preparation areas.

Only 1 plug not exceeding 2000 W per competitor is available on the competition floor, and only 1 device can be used at a time on this plug (no multiple adapters).

Test 2 OMC Hair by Night

Ladies - Technical Combination Category (with Creative)
Same or different Mannequin Head
Automatic Combination Team Selection
No competitor age indication - all ages accepted

The competitors proceed to the assigned working stations with their mannequin heads' hair prepared in advance. The competitors will be asked to brush the hair. During the passage of the Wise Men, all competitors will be asked to move away from their mannequin heads and wait on the side of the competition floor. After the passage of the Wise Men who will brush all mannequins' hair in the direction that was prepared, the General Commissioner will call the competitors back to their mirrors and start the competition.

- 1. **Styling tools** All styling tools are allowed.
- 2. **Shaving** Shaving the mannequin head is forbidden. At finish, the minimum hair length must be 3 cm.
- 3. <u>Color</u> A maximum of 3 harmonious transition color shades can be used, including the base color. The colors green and blue are forbidden. Spray colors are forbidden.
- 4. <u>Hairpiece(s)</u>
 a) A minimum of 1 and a maximum of 3 hairpieces may be used, but must not be pre-styled. The hair of the hairpieces can be cut and colored in advance and must be presented straight laying on the tables, ready to be brushed and inspected by the Wise Men.
 - b) The diameter of each hairpiece must not exceed 2 inches (5 cm) in any direction.
 - c) The hair length of the hairpieces is optional.
 - d) The hairpiece(s) must be added to the hairstyle during the allowed competition time. The hairpieces must not cover more than 40% of the surface of the head. The competitors can use scissors to clean up their style at the end of the competition within the allowed time.
 - e) Wigs are forbidden.
- 5. **Supports** The use of any kind of supports in the hairstyle and in the hairpiece(s) is forbidden.
- 6. **Ornaments** Ornaments are allowed.
- 7. **Extensions** Hair extensions are allowed, but must be applied prior to the test to create volume and add length and colors. They must not be applied all in one place to form a hairpiece or pony tail.
- 8. **Jury** The Jury will judge the general impression of the style and color. When judging, the judges must be able to see the complete hairstyle, including the top. If this is not the case, the stewards will put the mannequin holders lower.
- 9. Time 25 minutes

(3 additional minutes will be granted for dressing the mannequin heads after the announcement by the General Commissioner. No additional time will be given. Competitors who do not respect this rule will be penalized by 5 points).

10. Scores Maximum: 30 points Minimum: 25 points

No electric plugs and no mirrors are available in the competitor preparation areas.

Only 1 plug not exceeding 2000 W per competitor is available on the competition floor, and only 1 device can be used at a time on this plug (no multiple adapters).

Test 1 OMC Day Style (commercial)

Ladies – Fashion Combination Category (with Evening Style)
Mannequin Head or Live Model
Automatic Combination Team Selection
No competitor age indication - all ages accepted



The competitors proceed on stage with their models' / mannequin heads' hair straight and dry. The hair must not be prepared or curled in advance.

During the passage of the Wise Men, all competitors will be asked to move away from their models / mannequin heads and wait on the side of the competition floor. After the passage of the Wise Men who will check if the models' / mannequin heads' hair is straight, the General Commissioner will call the competitors back to their mirrors and start the competition. Technical finished styles will be penalized.

1.	Hair length	The hair must be shoulder length or longer. Layers are optional. The minimum layered
		length must be 10 cm, except in the bang area (see image above).

2. <u>Color</u> A maximum of 3 harmonious transition color shades can be used, including the base color.

The colors green and blue are forbidden. Spray colors are forbidden.

3. **Styling Tools** All styling tools are allowed.

4. **Styling** The finished style must be commercial and casual, 80% of the hair must be styled down.

20% can be styled back or up in one section of the hairstyle (not in several parts of the

hairstyle).

5. **Products** All fixing products are allowed.

6. **Supports** Pins are allowed.

7. **Ornaments** All kinds of ornaments are forbidden.

8. **Extensions** Hair extensions are allowed, but must be applied prior to the test to create volume and add

length and colors. They must not be applied all in one place to form a hairpiece or pony tail.

9. <u>Jury</u> The Jury will judge the general impression of the style and color. When judging, the judges

must be able to see the complete hairstyle, including the top. If this is not the case, the

stewards will put the chairs lower.

10. Time 20 minutes

(3 additional minutes will be granted for dressing the mannequin head after the announcement by the General Commissioner. No additional time will be given. Competitors

who do not respect this rule will be penalized by 5 points).

11. Scores Maximum: 30 points

Minimum: 25 points

No electric plugs and no mirrors are available in the competitor preparation areas.

Only 1 plug not exceeding 2000 W per competitor is available on the competition floor, and only 1 device can be used at a time on this plug (no multiple adapters).

Test 2 OMC Evening Style (commercial)

Ladies – Fashion Combination Category (with Day Style) Same or different model / mannequin head Automatic Combination Team Selection No competitor age indication - all ages accepted

The competitors proceed to the assigned working stations with their models' / mannequin heads' hair **straight** and open. The competitors will be asked to brush the hair straight back. During the passage of the Wise Men, all competitors will be asked to move away from their models / mannequin heads and wait on the side of the competition floor. After the passage of the Wise Men who will brush all models' / mannequin heads' hair, the General Commissioner will call the competitors back to their mirrors and start the competition.

Pins and/or rollers are forbidden prior to the start of the test. The competitors can use scissors to clean up their styles at the end of the competition within the allocated time. The Evening Hairstyle must not look like the Hair by Night.

1.	Hair length	The hair must be shoulder length or longer. Layers are optional. The minimum layered
		length must be 10 cm, except in the bang area.

2. <u>Color</u> A maximum of 3 harmonious transition color shades can be used, including the base color. The colors green and blue are forbidden. Spray colors are forbidden.

3. **Styling tools** All styling tools are allowed.

4. **Products** All products are allowed.

5. <u>Hairpieces</u> Hairpieces are forbidden. If a Wise Man doubts whether a hairpiece has been used, he may inspect it after the competition is over. If so, the competitor will be penalized.

6. **Supports** The use of any kind of supports in the hairstyle is forbidden.

7. **Ornaments** A maximum of two (2) decorative pins is allowed.

8. **Extensions** Hair extensions are forbidden.

9. <u>Jury</u> The Jury will judge the general impression of the style and color. When judging, the judges must be able to see the complete hairstyle, including the top. If this is not the

case, the stewards will put the chairs lower.

10. Time 20 minutes

(3 additional minutes will be granted for dressing the mannequin head after the announcement by the General Commissioner. No additional time will be given.

Competitors who do not respect this rule will be penalized by 5 points).

11. <u>Scores</u> Maximum: 30 points

Minimum: 25 points

No electric plugs and no mirrors are available in the competitor preparation areas.

Only 1 plug not exceeding 2000 W per competitor is available on the competition floor, and only 1 device can be used at a time on this plug (no multiple adapters).
